Open program.

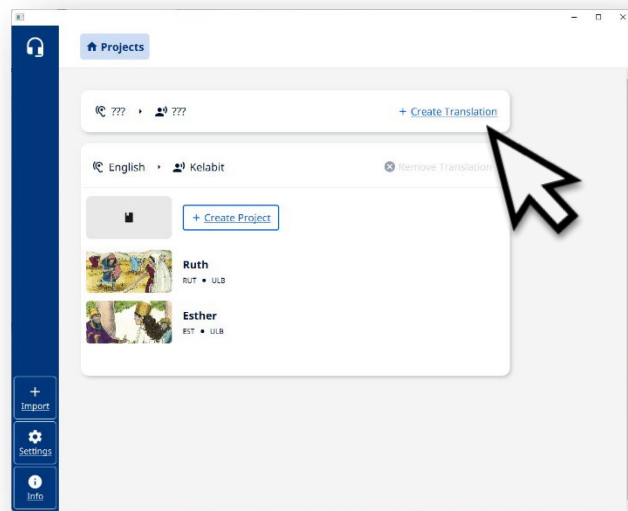
Click on the Orature icon.

Click on [Create Translation](#).

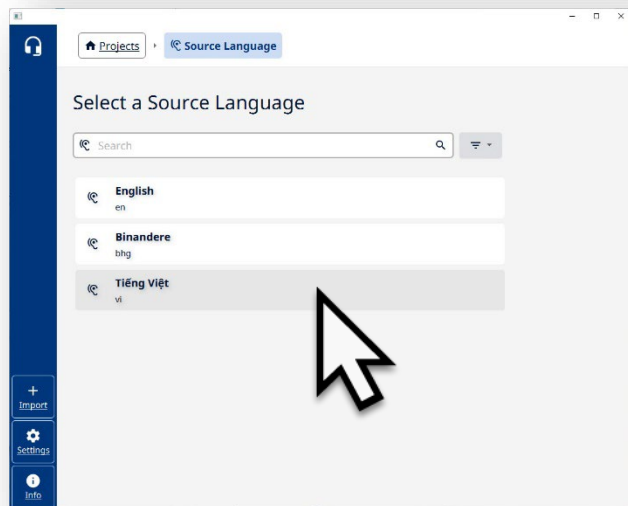


3

Click on the desired bar to select the source language.

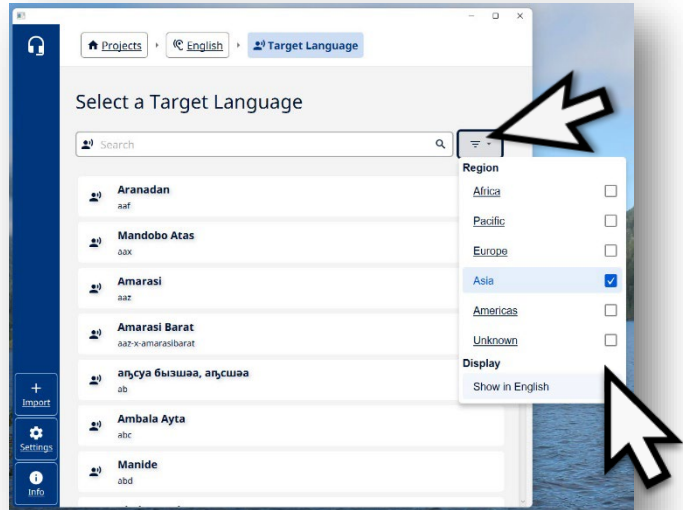
For other Source Languages, see the 'Import a Source Language' document.

Filter for the region.

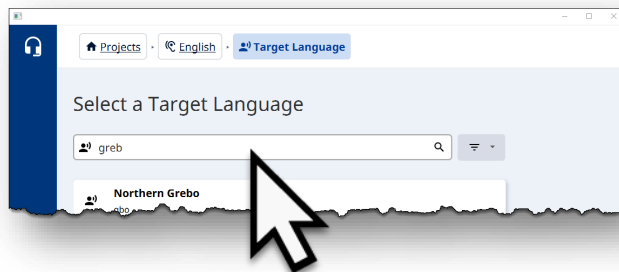
Click on the down arrow.

Scroll the list or type in the name of the target language.

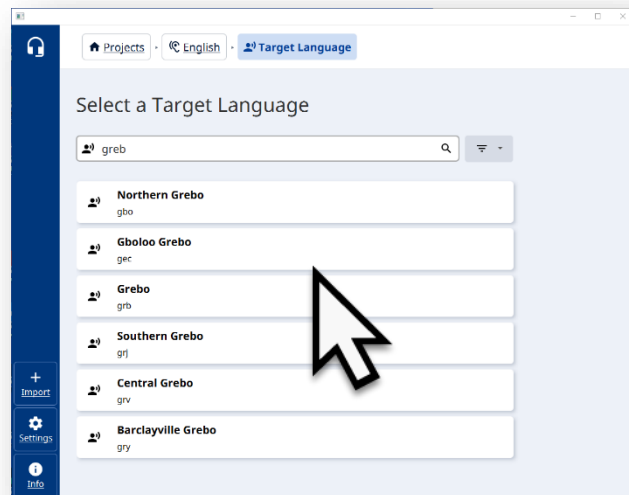


6

Click on language name bar.

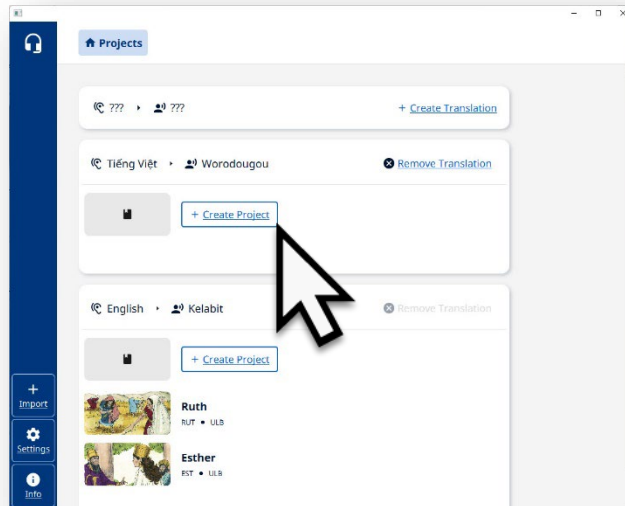
Orature returns to the Project screen with the new Translation pair listed at the top.

In the new translation pair card, click on [+ Create Project](#).

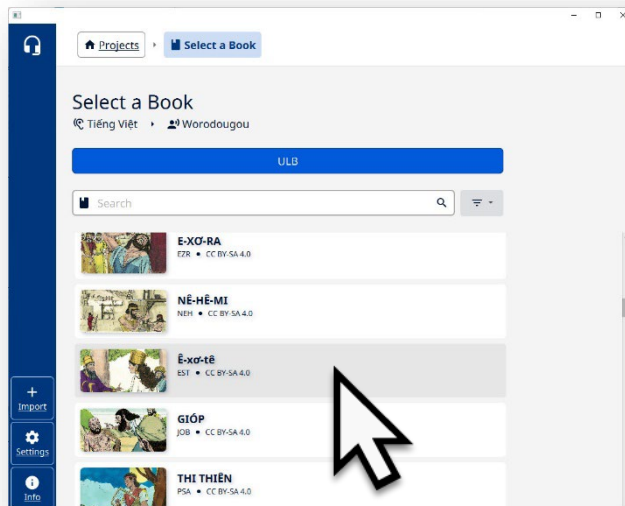
