

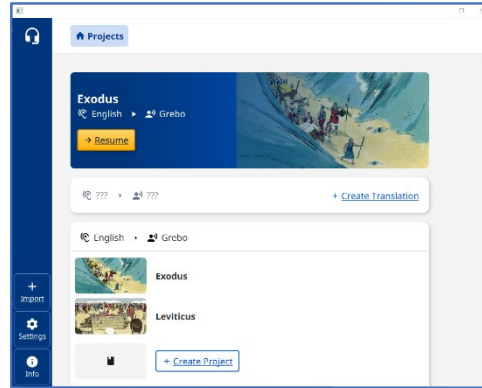
# Import Source Audio

# 1

Open Program.

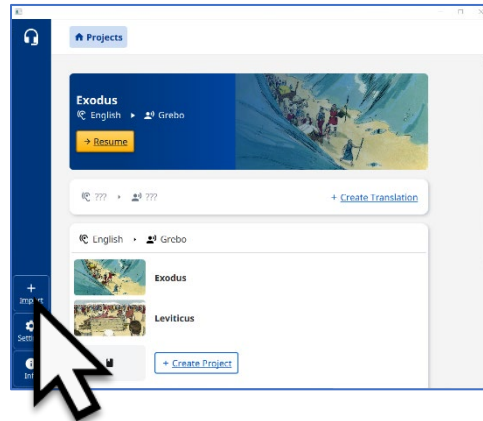
Click on the Orature icon. The program opens to the projects page.



# 2

Open Import sidebar.

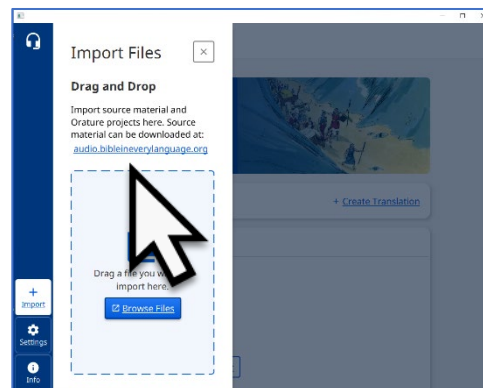
Click on the Import link in the left blue bar.



# 3

Go to Audio Bible in Every Language.

Click on the Bible in Every Language link.

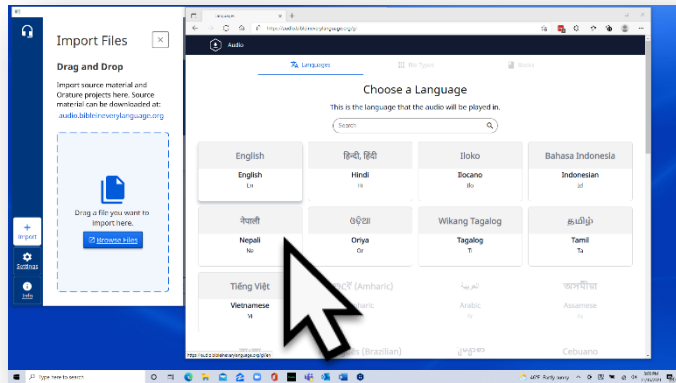


# 4

Select source language.

**NOTE:** Select the same language as the source language of the translation pair.

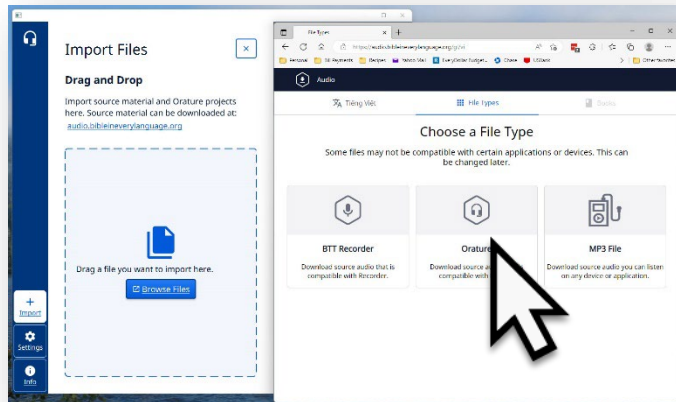
Click on the source language card.



# 5

Choose a File Type.

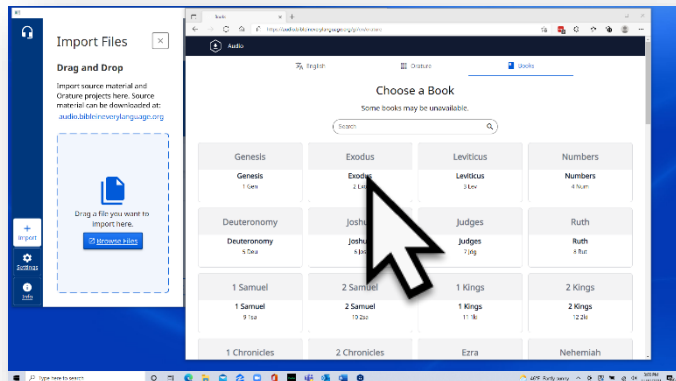
Click on the Orature card.



# 6

Select book.

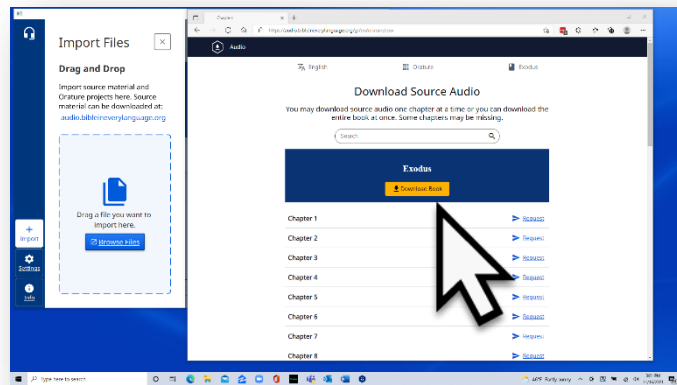
Click on the book card to choose the book.



# 7

Download book.

Click on the Download Book button.

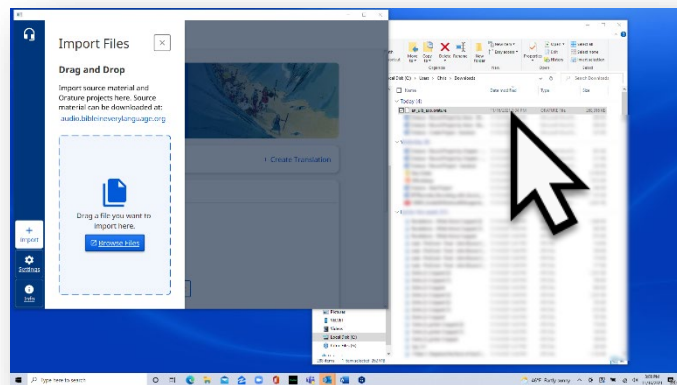


**NOTE:** You can choose to either download the entire book or each chapter separately.

Find file.

Open the File Manager and navigate to the Downloads folder.

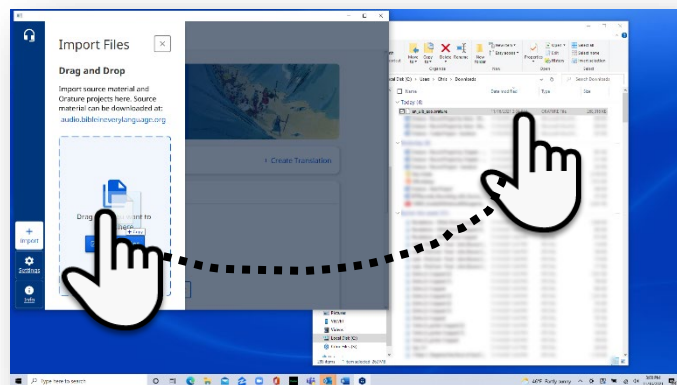


# 9

Drag file to Orature.

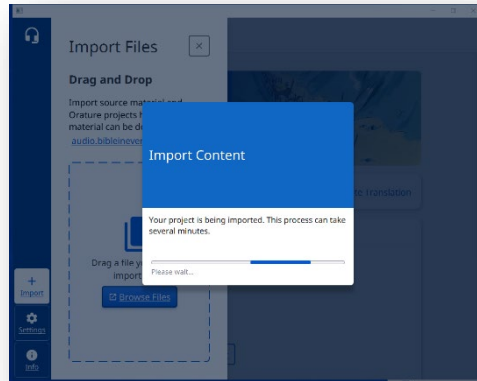
Look for a file with the .orature extension.

Left-click-hold the downloaded file and drag to the box in Orature program.



# 10

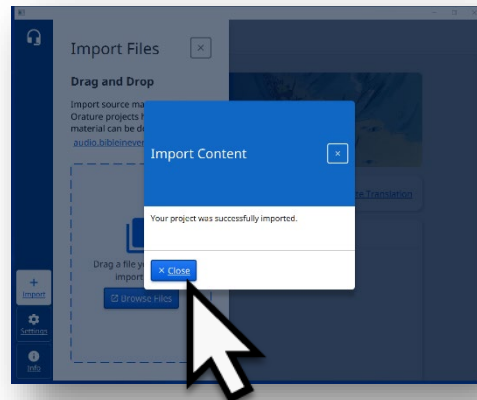
Wait for import.

Click close.

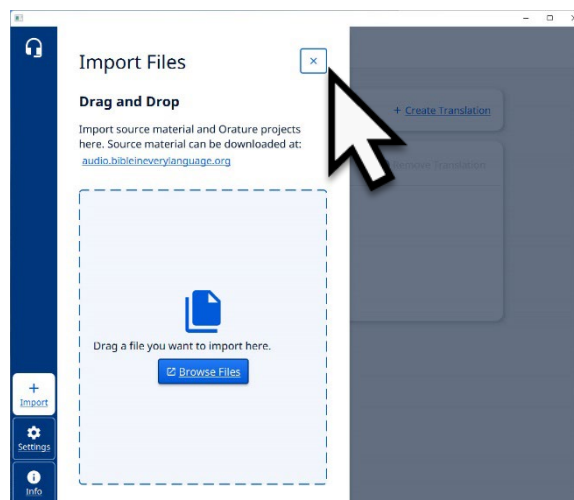
When the import is done, click the Close button.
